- C. CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Robert H. Bunch called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.
  - a) Roll call and establishment of Quorum –City Secretary – Jennifer Studdard

**Consideration/Approval of Agenda Items**

- D. Consideration and possible action to approve the minutes for the December 9, 2019 Public Hearing and Regular Council Meeting – Motion made by Councilmember Danica Porter and seconded by Councilmember Jimmy Norwood. All in Favor.
- E. Presentation to request a waiver for Ordinance 07-05B; An Ordinance by the City Council of the City of Nash, Texas, prohibiting billboards within the corporate boundaries of Nash, Texas, providing a penalty for violations of this Ordinance; Establishing an effective date; and containing a saving clause. Mr. Joe Thomas with Lindmark Outdoor Media started his presentation by stating that they currently have a billboard located on the property owned by BWI and there is a dispute going on with this family because they would like the sign removed and Lindmark still has 10 years left on their contract. Mr. Thomas stated that they would like to cooperate and relocate this sign, but they would need a waiver for the ordinance that the City of Nash currently has in place so they can relocate the sign somewhere in Nash. Doug Bowers made a recommendation not to approve the waiver and keep the current ordinance intact.
- F. Consideration and/or possible action to approve request for waiver on Ordinance 07-05B – A motion was made by Councilmember Jimmy Norwood to deny a waiver at this time and seconded by Councilmember Danica Porter. All in Favor.
- G. Mayor Robert Bunch order the General Election to be held on May 2, 2020 – a motion was made by Councilmember Danica Porter and seconded by Councilmember Charles Underwood. All in Favor.

**H.** Consideration and/or possible action to approve Resolution 01-2020; A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Nash, Texas, authorizing the submission of a HOME Application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs; and authorizing the Mayor, Robert Bunch, to act as the City’s Executive Officer, authorized signatory, and authorized representative in all matters pertaining to the City’s participation in the HOME Program reservation system agreement. Kathy Boyles explained that this Resolution is for the submission of the HOME Application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs – a motion was made by Councilmember Charles Underwood to approve Resolution 01-2020 and seconded by Councilmember Jimmy Norwood. All in Favor.
