- C. CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Robert H. Bunch called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

- D. Consideration and possible action to approve the minutes for the January 27, 2020 Regular Council Meeting – Motion made by Councilmember Charles Underwood and seconded by Councilmember Cranford Graves. All in Favor.
- E. Consideration and/or possible action to approve Resolution 02-2020; A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Nash, Texas, approving the Mayor to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Avery, the City of Dekalb, the City of Hooks and the City of Wake Village for cooperation in reviewing, drafting, negotiating and finalizing the Riverbend Contract through Legal Counsel – A motion was made by Councilmember Dale Vickers to approve Resolution 02-2020 and seconded by Councilmember Jimmy Norwood. Consideration and/or possible action to approve Ordinance 02-2020; an Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Nash, Texas, changing the name of the street known as County Road 2216, be officially changed to Steele Lane; an establishing an effective date – a motion was made by Councilmember Cranford Graves to approve Ordinance 02-2020 and seconded by Councilmember Charles Underwood. H. Consideration and/or possible action to approve Ordinance 02-2020B; An Ordinance of the City of Nash, Texas; providing for the location of stop signs. Specifically on Steele Lane at the intersection of Brinlee and on Steele Lane at the intersection of Alumax Road, all pursuant to the City's inherent Police powers; providing that violations of same will constitute a misdemeanor; providing penalties for violations of the ordinance, and providing that this ordinance shall become effective immediately – a motion was made by Councilmember Charles Underwood to approve Ordinance 02-2020B and seconded by Councilmember Cranford Graves.
