Consideration and possible action to approve the minutes for the October 13, 2020 Public Hearing and Regular Council Meeting and the minutes for the October 22, 2020 Public Hearing & Special Called Meeting. – Motion made by Councilmember Charles Underwood and seconded by Councilmember Danica Porter. - E. Consideration and/or possible action to approve Resolution R11-2020; A resolution suspending SWEPCO’s proposed effective date related to its statement of intent to increase rates submitted to the City on about October 13, 2020; engaging special counsel to represent the City with regard to SWEPCO’s statement of intent; authorizing intervention in proceedings related to SWEPCO’s statement of intent through a coalition of cities known as Cities Advocating Reasonable Deregulation (“CARD”); and directing SWEPCO to reimburse the City’s reasonable rate case expenses related to SWEPCO’s statement of intent.– A motion was made by Councilmember Jimmy Norwood to approve Resolution R11-2020 and seconded by Councilmember Cranford Graves. Open Forum/Citizens Comments:

1. Billie McCready - #5 Bella - Ms. McCready stated that she has called the electrical and cable companies several times trying to get them to come and bury their lines and has had no luck getting them to take care of this matter. Ms. McCready is also having a problem with them not mowing the property. Doug Bowers, City Administrator explained to Ms. McCready that Darrin Lafayette has been out there and looked at the situation and the lines are supposed to be buried. Darrin Lafayette has been in contact with the utility companies but due to COVID, the utility companies are shorthanded and have not been able to send anyone out there to remedy the problem. Ms. McCready asked if the City has an Ordinance for no parking on Bella? Doug Bowers, City Administrator explained to Ms. McCready that Bella is a private drive, and the City cannot put parking signs on private drives.
